



## Scouting Skills WINTER EVENT LakeLaCygne / Linn County Park

**When:** Friday February 23<sup>th</sup>, 2018 to Sunday February 25<sup>th</sup>.

**Where:** *Shelter House at Lake LaCygne / Linn County Park*

43 miles / 45 min. Head South on US-69 (approx. 35 miles) to West 399<sup>th</sup> St. in Sugar Creek. Take 399<sup>th</sup> St. exit turn right(west) onto West 399<sup>th</sup> St., go 4/10<sup>th</sup> mile turn left(South) onto Jingo Road – go 1 miles, continue onto Ulery Road. Turn left (East) onto East 2400<sup>th</sup> Road (go under HWY 69) go 1.7 miles Turn right (south) into Linn County Park. Head to large shelter

**Meet:** 5:30 at Atonement Friday February 23th

**What:** We will be heading back to LaCygne for a winter camp out. Here we will build a fire in the enclosed shelter, play board games, work on scout skills and present ourselves to webelo scouts that may have an interest in joining troop 257.



**Meals:** To Be Determined. Because the buffalo patrol will be preparing food for visiting webelos, we need to determine if we will work together as a troop on all meals, or prepare meals by Patrol (Saturday Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner, and Sunday Breakfast)
